

INFORMATION GUIDE

In the school of September to March the climate is: **Spring**, the temperature this between 10 to 28 heat degrees. The **Summer** is of 15 to 32 degrees, we recommended that they bring bath suit if therefore you wish it, because in addition to a swimming pool that we have, this also the beach.

If I am foreign, since I make to obtain a visa?

You do not need visa, you can enter the country like tourist and once being here, she would begin you transact them to be in the country the necessary time. But serious good that you consulted to the embassy before coming, because if there is some problem, we would send a letter invitation to enter the country.

How it would be the insurance of Health?

If you already have an insurance (if he is foreign, the insurance must be international) is no problem, but if you do not have it when arriving at Pichilemu, you need to remove to the medical card that helps you for any simple emergency, which has a cost of USS 3.

How would pay the school?

The school to accept Chilean money or American dollar, can be cancelled the partial total or payments month to month (6 quotas), that can with check to date guarantee their quotas.

What you need to bring

Bath towels, Savannahs, Coat to sleep, Sketch books, Notebook to develop books, Pencils, Bible, Magazines to remove cuts, a cup, clamps of clothes for washings, equipment of personal, detergent cleanliness for your clothes.

When I can arrive?

A day before the beginning of the school, if you want to come before, you can, but it will have to maintain all your expenses until a day before gives the school.

How it is possible to be arrived?

If you are Chilean, you must come direct to Pichilemu in the 6 Region, if you are foreign and you come in airplane, you need to warn when you arrive and we would send by you at a person, but you you would have to pay the trip. If you arrive in Bus, in the same terminal there are Buses that come to Pichilemu, it consults the information and they will say to you where you can find the bus.

Which is the electrical voltage of Chile?

In the country the current that is used is 220 V, but also are transforming that can elevate or lower the voltage.

How it is the lodging?

The space is limited and in the rooms they sleep up to 4 people. For marriages they are generally external, rent outside the base, because it is a base in construction.

And for the marriages that have children? How it would be?

There is personnel that takes care of of the children during the hours of classes.

How it would be the feeding?

The food is typical of Chile, all eat in community (DTS), is not allowed to cook aside. They are 3 daily meals that consist of breakfast, lunch and has supper. For the marriages, they cook aside if therefore they wish it. And those that need a special diet by reason for some disease are possible that it cooks aside.

If you want to have break between the meals, you must buy it.

How it is the climate in Pichilemu?

In the schools of March to September the climate is: **Autumn**, the temperature this between 5 degrees and 20 degrees celcius, and in **Winter** but the cold thing can arrive up to 1 degree celcius, the maximum that can have is 15 degrees, and also much rain with very strong winds.

We recommended that they bring raincoats and boots of water.
